Looking upward in the Eastern sky, you will see the February 12, 2025 Full Moon. Referred to as the Snow Moon or the Eagle Moon named because typically heavy snowfall occurs in February. According to the National Weather Service, on average February is the snowiest month. We just experienced that last week. In the 1760s, Captain Jonathan Carver who had visited with the Naudowessie (Dakota), wrote that the name used for this period was the Snow Moon, “because more snow commonly falls during this month than any other in the winter.”
